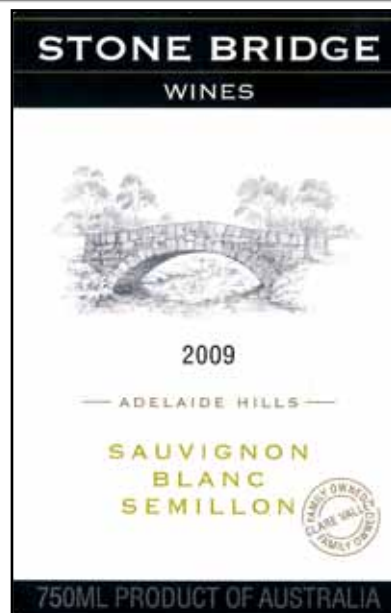
Speaker for April meeting

Apple juice available at 70 cents per litre. Some apple/strawberry, apple/rhubarb and pear juice will also be available.

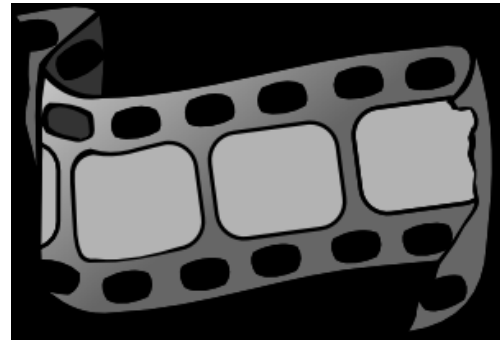
Members wishing to purchase more than 100 litres should contact Geoff directly on 8390 1648.
